He is an expert on mobile devices and Bluetooth technology, experience that inspired the development of COOKOO and COGITO, the world's first designer connected watches.

Prior to establishing CONNECTEDEVICE, Mr Olivier was CEO of BLUETREK Technologies, maker of award-winning Bluetooth headsets. From 2003-2006, he served as a board member of ModeLabs Group, a high-end mobile handset manufacturer which he co-founded. In 2006, Mr Olivier helped guide the company's successful IPO on the Paris Stock Exchange NYSE-Euronext.
